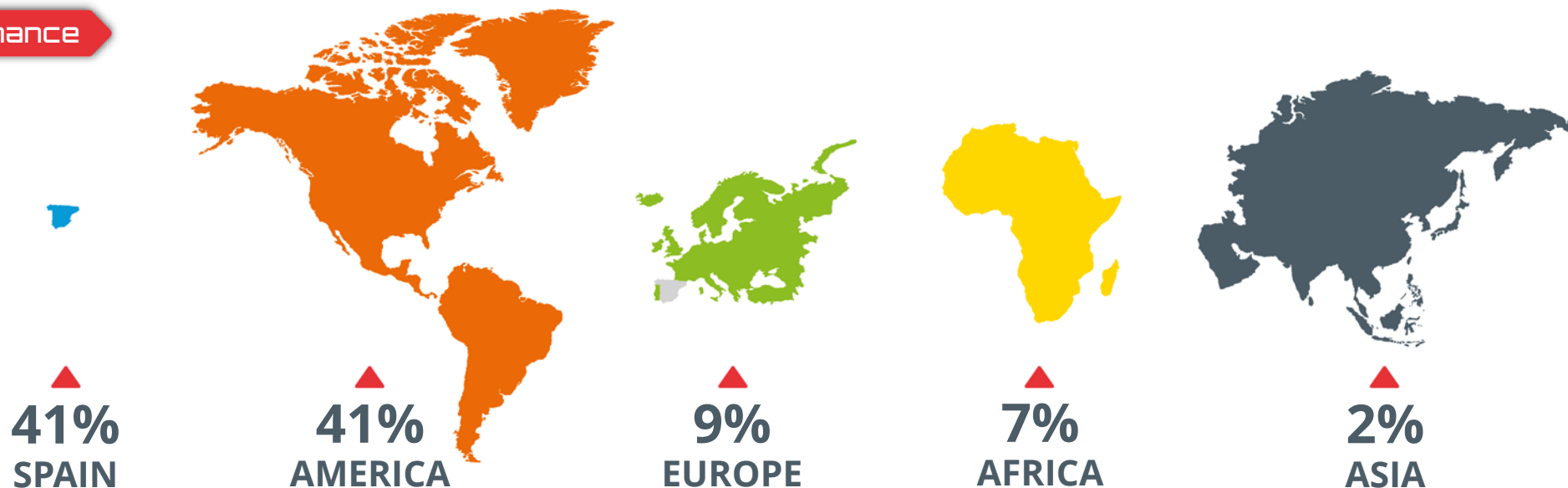

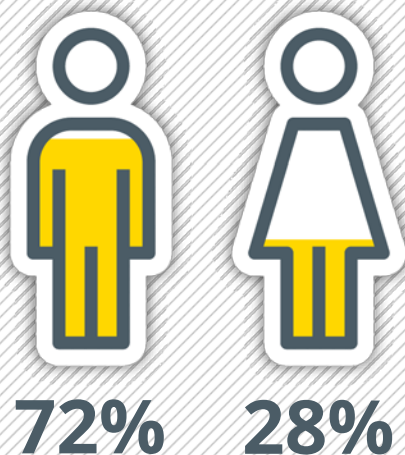


Detailed Results Cybersecurity Summer BootCamp 2018

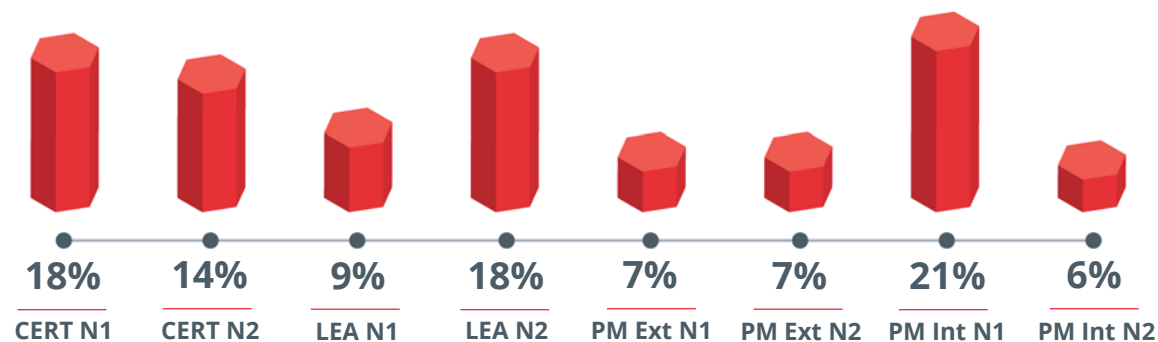
Provenance
