Massive Scam: Dismantling the Global Infrastructure of Online Fraud

Abstract

The aim of this presentation is to show the audience a piece of research carried out by INCIBE in support of State Law Enforcement Forces and Agencies in the fight against cybercrimes with regard online fraud. This directly affects Spain: specifically almost 2% of Spanish domains have been affected. The complex research carried out to identify all the infrastructure behind this fraud will be presented as will the subsequent mitigation and notification carried out by the CERT of INCIBE, which as well as affecting .ES, also affects other TLDs such as .CO, .COM, .FR, .IT, .DE, .SE and more, with more than 200,000 fraudulent domains on a global level.
